



KOREAN SPEAKING FAMILY ADVOCATE (FULL TIME)

JOB DESCRIPTION: KAFSC is a non-profit organization specializing in counseling, family violence intervention, community education, and social services to Korean immigrant families. KAFSC is seeking a Family Advocate, who will manage and assist with several Domestic Violence (DV) intervention and prevention programs targeting Korean American women, men and youth. Full-time position that includes evenings and some weekend work. **Individual must be fluent in Korean and have DV experience.**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Work closely with API and Korean DV shelters directors and consultant to develop a Korean DV Response Network in Los Angeles.
- Outreach and build relationships with other DV first responders and services providers.
- Develop measurement tools to track progress to report back to funders.
- Assist with Korean DV community needs assessment and evaluation including conducting interviews, organizing data, and writing reports.
- Assist with DV public awareness and prevention efforts, including help develop brochures, training materials, Public Service Announcements, etc.
- Coordinate meetings and help plan conferences and seminars.
- Conduct media outreach and make community presentations to raise awareness of the Response Network.
- Facilitate Korean language DV Batterers' Treatment, Anger Management, and AA group classes targeting batterers and at-risk Korean immigrants.
- Answer crisis calls to Korean DV hotline.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree preferred (preferably MSW, MFT or comparable degree).
- Strong initiative and able to work independently.
- Ability to multi-task and work on several projects at once.
- Experience in program planning, program development and implementation, and program evaluation a plus.
- Must work several weekday evenings per week and occasional weekends.
- Publishing, website development, and/or social media skills a plus.
- Experience working with Korean immigrants, mental health consumers, or family violence victims a plus.
- Must pass TB test and Live Scan fingerprint clearance;
- Must have valid driver's license, proof of auto insurance, and access to a car
- **Must have experience working in DV or similar/related services.**
- **Must speak, read and write Korean fluently.**
